FWP has a written Health & Safety Policy and system. The managing partners, through the guidance of their Health and Safety Officer, are responsible for ensuring compliance with the Health and Safety Regulations

FWP has a health and safety at work system. It is the policy of FWP, to ensure that, so far as is reasonably practicable:

- › working conditions for all members of staff are safe and healthy
- › any operations or working practices carried out do not adversely affect any members of staff or members of the public etc
- › all statutory Regulations and Codes of Practice are complied with
- › provision of safe systems of work for all members of staff, including travelling and visits to site
- › provision of appropriate information, training and supervision to encourage a sense of responsibility towards health and safety issues by all members of staff

FWP also accepts its responsibility for other persons who may be affected by its activities and will ensure that its statutory duties and obligations will be complied with at all times.
